# 2022-2023 TCS NEW USER CHECKLIST

Welcome to the Teacher Course Student (TCS) collection! Please use the following checklist to prepare yourself for the collection:

☐ Obtain your username and password from your <u>LEA Security Manager</u>. TCS is a Portal Application, which means that each user has a unique username and password. You should not be given the credentials from someone whose position you filled, a new account should be assigned to you, and any others working on TCS. Once you are assigned the TCS User Role, you will automatically be on my email list and will receive updates and announcements pertaining to the collection. Visit the Communication section of the Documentation page of the Help Site to read email that has already been sent during the current school year. ☐ Bookmark the Help Site. url: https://portal.ct.gov/SDE/Performance/Data-Collection-Help-Sites/TCS-Help-Site The site includes everything you need for a successful collection such as documentation, FAQ's, statutory references and more. ☐ Familiarize yourself with the User Guide. The Record Layout defines all of the data fields collected in TCS. The User Guide is available on the **Documentation** page of the Help Site. ☐ Even if you are not yet entering data, log in to TCS to familiarize yourself with the TCS application itself. Explore the various screens and reports. ☐ Note the deadlines and what is required for each time frame. The deadlines are posted on the first page of the Help Site and are included in every email.

If you are a new user, I strongly recommend you start the collection early so there is ample time to provide any assistance needed and still meet the deadline. I also encourage you to contact me with any questions, feedback or ideas you have on improving this collection.
