




INTERNET EXPLORER TRANSITION

The Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) “legacy” applications (e.g., PSIS, ED166) could only be accessed via Internet Explorer for many years. Several of these applications now support Chrome and Edge, but the web server itself is still in the process of being upgraded. Until the upgrade is complete, you may see a security warning in modern browsers when browsing to the site.

Please be aware of the following if using Edge; Chrome is similar:

	<p>After logging in to https://www.csde.state.ct.us you will likely see a security warning.</p> <p>Click the “Advanced” button.</p>
	<p>A warning about TLS version appears. Click the “Proceed to www.csde.state.ct.us (unsafe)” link.</p>
	<p>You should see the usual landing page for the CSDE “legacy” collection server. Click the Enter button. You will then be prompted for your “legacy” login as usual.</p> <p>Be sure to add “sdectw\” prior to the username. To be able to type in the username textbox, you may need to choose “use other credentials” or similar. Once past the sign-in popup, you will be on the CSDE legacy application menu page.</p>
