

# Why do we care about the FAFSA (1/3)?



In Connecticut, FAFSA completion is strongly correlated with postsecondary enrollment, particularly for students eligible for Free or Reduced-Price Meals.






# Why do we care about the FAFSA (2/3)?



High school graduates identified as having high needs earn more than their peers without a postsecondary credential, regardless of their high-needs status.





# Why do we care about the FAFSA (3/3)?





The FAFSA (and AACTUS) unlocks multiple streams of federal, state, and institutional aid for students, including grants, loans, and work study.



#### Federal Sources of Aid:

- **Pell Grant** (Up to \$7,395 per year)
- Supplemental Educational Opportunity
   Grant (Up to \$4,000 a year)
- Iraq and Afghanistan Service Grant (Up to \$7,395 per year)
- **TEACH Grant** (Up to \$4,000 per year)



- Roberta B. Willis Scholarship Merit (Up to \$5,250 a year)
- Roberta B. Willis Scholarship Need (Up to \$4,500 a year)
- CT Minority Teacher Incentive Grant (Up to \$5,000)










#### **Deep Student Trust in School Counselors**




How much trust do you have in each of the following as a source of information about higher education institutions?





# **Statewide FAFSA Completion Rate**








# FAFSA Completion Rate State vs. FAFSA Challenge High Schools
