Regional School Choice Fair Saturday, Oct. 17

First fair of lottery application season to feature programming for Grades PK to 12

(HARTFORD, Conn.) – October13, 2015 -- Want to explore the many great opportunities for your child's education within the Greater Hartford region? Want to speak with staff and families that work at or attend a magnet school or the Hartford Region Open Choice Program? Bring the family to the first regional school choice fair of the 2016-17 lottery application season on **Saturday, October 17, 2015** from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. at A.I. Prince Technical High School, 401 Flatbush Ave., Hartford.

Families may pre-register online for the Prince Tech fair at RSCO's web site (<u>www.choiceeducation.org</u>). Look for the 'Pre-Register' link under 'News & Events' on the main page.

Important notes about RSCO and the lottery:

- The 2016-17 lottery application period opens October 15, 2015 and closes on Friday, January 29, 2016.
- There are approximately **43 magnet school options** with specialized themes available; Hartford and suburban students may apply.
- The Hartford Region Open Choice Program is a separate option on the RSCO lottery application. Students apply to attend a non-magnet public school outside of their hometown. Once enrolled, Hartford residents may attend school in their Open Choice district through high school graduation.
- The largest numbers of available seats tend to be in transition grades, particularly prekindergarten, kindergarten, grade 6 and grade 9.

The fair will feature information about the wide array of options available to Hartford and suburban students entering pre-kindergarten through grade 12. RSCO partners include: the Capitol Region Education Council; Hartford Public Schools' Host Magnet Program; the Hartford Region Open Choice Program; Goodwin College's Early Childhood Magnet School and CT River Academy; the Connecticut Technical High School System; Bloomfield Public Schools' Wintonbury Early Childhood Magnet School and The Global Experience Magnet School; East Hartford Public Schools' Connecticut IB Academy; and the Suffield Regional Agriscience Center.

If you are new to this experience, there will be a video presentation to provide an overview of the RSCO lottery application process. After viewing the presentation, RSCO staff will be available to answer

specific questions. Families will also have the opportunity to submit an online application for the 2016-17 RSCO lottery. The lottery is not first-come, first-served and families are encouraged to make an informed decision.

"Our goal is to provide information and improve access for students throughout the region who choose to apply to public schools outside of their community," said Glen Peterson, RSCO's Division Director. "Through our four fairs held between October and January, as well as many scheduled school and program-based open houses and information sessions, families can learn about the schools and specialized programs in our region that emphasize exciting educational themes," he adds.
