Historical Thinking Skills

Historical Thinking	Questions to ask yourself
Sourcing	 Who wrote this? What is the author's point of view? When was it written? What else do we know about the historical context? Who is the intended audience? What was the author's purpose for making it?
Comparison	 What is similar about these accounts? What is different about these accounts? Why are these accounts similar or different? How does sourcing lead to these similarities and differences?
Corroboration	 What do other documents say? Do the documents agree? If not, why? What are other possible documents? What documents are the most reliable?
Contextualization	 When and where was the document created? What was different at that time? What was the same as now? How might the circumstances in which the document was created affect its content?
Causation	 What was the outcome of this event? What were all of the causes? Which cause or causes immediately led to the outcome? Which cause or causes were underlying?
