<b>MODIFICATIONS FOR NEW AWARDEES FY 20-21</b>	
<b>Types of Programs</b>	<b>Change:</b> *Summer and Residential programs will not be funded for FY 20-21 programs.
<b>Application Deadline Extension</b>	<b>Change-</b> Application proposals are due from applicants before or on <b>April 27, 2020</b> by 4:00pm
<b>10-page limit</b>	<b>No Change-</b> The 10-page limit applies to the Program Narrative section only and not to any other supplemental documentation ( <b>see RFP p. 4</b> )
<b>Face to Face Contact Hours</b>	<b>No Change-</b> Programs will have the full academic year to implement face-to-face interactions.

\*With the current COVID-19 pandemic conditions there has been a decision not to offer funding to summer or residential programs because of the possibility that summer and residential programs may not be able to operate this year. Applicants may focus on all-year programs with a target start date in September 2020.
