### Lead Awareness and Management Challenge (LAMC)

for Leadership Teams in Connecticut Public and Non-Profit Private Schools

#### Overview

The Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) in collaboration with the Connecticut State Department of Public Health (DPH) is offering a funding opportunity to support the participation of leadership teams from public and private non-profit schools to attend a workshop on lead poisoning prevention and intervention for educators. Through stimulating presentations and action-oriented activities school teams will learn up-to-date research related to the effects of lead exposure on child development and learning, school district responsibilities in identifying and intervening with students who have a history of lead poisoning, and resources available for training other school personnel.

### Lead Poisoning Awareness and Management

At the workshop, team members will be introduced to new guidelines for educators related to:

- lead prevention;
- early identification of students exposed and affected by lead:
- educational programming in response to lead exposure in order to mitigate or eliminate existing or potential deficits; and

#### Criteria for Lead Advisory Team Members

To participate in the workshop, each applicant must create a lead advisory team. This team may include the following representatives:

- school nurse supervisor/school nurse;
- school nutrition staff:
- teacher/special education/pupil services administrator;
- school psychologist; and
- preschool/early childhood administrator.

If a school district/school/program does not have the mandatory personnel, it can provide an explanation on the application and suggest alternate team members. No more than five team members will be accepted.



### Responsibilities of Lead Advisory Team

Each team will be expected to:

- attend a workshop on April 9, 2014;
   become knowledgeable about the CSDE Lead
- Awareness and Management Guidelines;
- write an action plan for promoting lead poisoning awareness among its agency personnel at the workshop; and
- develop administrative procedures related to lead poisoning prevention and intervention by the end of 2014.

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### Compensation

A) Each <u>new</u> school/school district participating in this initiative shall receive a \$3,500 stipend for:

- ✓ attendance at the full-day workshop (April 9, 2014); and
- implementation of agreed upon lead poisoning awareness and management activities.

B) Each school/school district <u>re-applying</u> for participating in this initiative shall receive a \$1,500 stipend for:

- attendance and presentation of their 2013 implementation activities at the workshop (April 9, 2014); and
- implementation of agreed upon lead poisoning awareness and management activities.

The Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) only distributes CHR and HAR forms to public school districts. You are responsible for providing the health care providers in your community with forms.
