






CT-SEDS INTERFACE: Add Supplementary Aid/Service






CT-SEDS INTERFACE: Add Supplementary Aid/Service






CT-SEDS INTERFACE: Add Accommodation












CT-SEDS INTERFACE: Add Modification




CT-SEDS INTERFACE: Add Assistive Technology






CT-SEDS INTERFACE: Add Adult Support





CT-SEDS INTERFACE: Add Adult Support





Supplementary aids and services include accommodations, modifications, assistive technology, and adult support.

- One of the goals in designing the new system was to encourage the thoughtful selection of essential supplementary aids and services for use in specific settings.
- There is a panel to record supplementary aids and services in both annual goal domain areas: 1) academic/cognitive achievement, and 2) functional performance as well as the Secondary Transition section.
- Adult support is used to document more intensive support to a student (e.g., 1:1 aide).
