What indicators and improvement strategies would you prioritize?

- All of the Indicators are important!
- Graduation (Ind. 1).
 - Data Analysis for Individual Districts to assess Root Cause.
- Dropout Rates (Ind. 2).
 - Possible Factor: When Students at CTECs are not able to study their chosen area
 of focus, this would lead to lack of interest/engagement in school.
- Suspension and Exclusion (Ind.4).
- Secondary Transition (Ind. 13).
 - The importance of translation services for parents to be meaningful participants in the PPT process.
 - o How can we help school districts get beyond compliance?
 - All transitions in school are important, are there ways the CSDE can study all transitions (i.e., B-3 to PreK, PreK to K, Elementary to Middle, Middle to High School).

 - Provide more bilingual supports
 - Use social media and school-based communications
 - Provide tutorials/short videos
 - o Give more notice to parents when and why they are receiving the survey.
