FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Is the student's IEP appropriate?
- 2. If not, is a placement at a private school appropriate?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

The matter was assigned on August 15, 2001. The original date for the mailing of the final decision and order was September 28, 2001. Prehearing conferences were held on August 22, 2001, and on September 10, 2001.
