**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

**ISSUES:**

1. Whether the Board's proposed program for the Student for the 2004-2005 school year is appropriate.
2. If not, whether the Parent's proposed placement of the Student is appropriate.

**SUMMARY:**

This matter was assigned on September 10, 2004. A prehearing conference was held on September 15. An extension of the mailing date of the decision was granted in accordance with Section 10-76h-9(e) of the Connecticut Regulations which provides for a 30 day postponement for settlement discussions between the parties. On the first day of hearing on November 15, the parties attempted to finalize a settlement, which settlement agreement was finalized by the conclusion of the day.

**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The matter is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice.
