## FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

## PROCEDURAL HISTORY

This hearing was requested on November 3, 2004. This hearing officer was assigned to the case on November 4. A prehearing conference was held on November 10. The parties believed they could resolve the case among themselves. A hearing date was agreed on for December 14. The Parent's attorney filed exhibits and a witness list on December 7. The Board did not file a witness list or exhibits. At the hearing on December 14, the Parent's attorney appeared without the Parent. The Board's attorney was present accompanied by Ms. Jody Lefkowitz, Senior Director Exceptional Children. The attorneys requested time to discuss a settlement, which was granted. After a time the parties reported that they had reached an agreement in principle, which they would submit in writing within one week.
