## FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

## **SUMMARY:**

This matter was assigned on November 19 as an expedited hearing as the Parent was challenging the Board's action in disciplining the Student for behaviors that were claimed to be a manifestation of the Student's disability. On November 19, the Board's attorney submitted a notice that the Parent had withdrawn a case on November 18, and that another hearing request had been dismissed without prejudice on November 17. A prehearing conference was held on November 22, and hearing dates were scheduled for December 7, 10, 15 and 17. On November 28, the Parent submitted a request that the matter be dismissed without prejudice.
