## FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

## **SUMMARY:**

This matter was assigned on November 24, 2004, and a prehearing conference was held on December 2. On December 17, the attorney for the Parents submitted a request for an extension of the mailing date of the decision so that the parties could attempt to settle the matter. That request was granted in accordance with Section 10-76h-9(e) of the Connecticut Regulations which provides for a 30-day postponement for settlement discussions between the parties.
