## **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

The Board requested this hearing to address medical issues and issues of transportation. The prehearing conference was held on March 7, 2005. The Student participated and the Board did not. The Board's counsel subsequently notified the hearing officer that the Student's counsel would be providing the hearing officer with mutually agreeable dates to reschedule the prehearing conference. No such dates were forthcoming.
