## **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

### **ISSUES:**

- 1. Whether the Board's proposed program for the Student for the 2006-07 school year is appropriate.
- 2. If not, whether the Board shall provide the Student a tutor or an education assistant for science coursework.
- 3. Whether the Student shall be moved to college prep English for the 2006-07 school year.
- 4. Whether the Board appropriately considered transition in the Student's IEP.
- 5. Whether the Student's interests/concerns were appropriately considered by the Board members of the PPT.

## **SUMMARY:**

The Board received this request for hearing on June 6, 2006. A prehearing conference was held on June 14. On July 10 the hearing convened, at which time it was confirmed that the matter was settled, and that the Parent agreed to a dismissal with prejudice as all issues raised in her hearing request were resolved.

#### **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The matter is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice.
