## FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

## PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Parent (Father) filed a due process hearing request with the Ansonia Board of Education on October 27, 2006. The Board sent a copy to the State Department of Education (SDE) on that date. This Hearing Officer was assigned to the case on October 30. On November 7 a notice of a prehearing conference scheduled for November 14 was sent to the Parent and the Board's attorney. On November 9 the Board's attorney sent the Hearing Officer a copy of the Parent's letter to the Director of Special Education and "it's attorney's office (Patricia M. Strong)" indicating that he was satisfied with the outcome at a PPT meeting the previous day and wished to withdraw his complaint. The Hearing Officer wrote a letter to the parties on November 12 and advised them that the case would be dismissed. The mailing date for the decision is January 11, 2007.

## FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

It is ordered that this case be dismissed.
