FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

SUMMARY

This special education hearing was requested via application dated May 2, 2007 by the Parent on behalf of Student, which was received by the Board on May 23, 2007. The 30-day resolution period ran from May 23, 2007 to June 22, 2007. The deadline for mailing the final decision and order is August 6, 2007.

A telephonic pre-hearing conference was held on June 4, 2007 and June 15, 2007 at which Attorney Moses appeared but the Parents did not. The parties participated in a resolution meeting prior to the June 4 pre-hearing conference. During the period between the two scheduled pre-hearing conferences, the parties resolved the matter. Via letter dated June 13, 2007, the Parents withdrew their due process request with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER
