FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board's proposed program for the Student for the 2007-2008 school year is appropriate.
- 2. If not, whether the Student shall be placed at Hope Academy, with transportation, for the 2007-2008 school year.
