FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES

I. Whether the local educational agency provides the child with a free and appropriate public education in a location which is agreeable to the parents?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parents through counsel requested a due process hearing on June 27, 2007. At a prehearing conference the parents requested a hearing date which would provide time to mediate the case. The parties agreed to a hearing commencing on August 16, 2007. On the first day of hearing, the parties announced they were able to reach agreement and would notify me whether the matter was to be dismissed with or without prejudice. Neither party has communicated since that date. The matter is dismissed without prejudice.

The matter was resolved within 45 days of the date for mailing the final decisions.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

1. The case is dismissed without prejudice.
