ISSUES

- I. Whether the child's evaluations are appropriate?
- II. Whether the child requires tutorial services?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parent requested a due process hearing challenging the accuracy of evaluations on November 11, 2007. At a prehearing conference the parties agreed to schedule a hearing for January 17, 2008. On the first day of hearing the parties reported they believed they had an agreement which needed to be drafted and executed. The Board of Education request the matter be dismissed with prejudice. The matter was resolved within 45 days as extended by the parties to pursue settlement negotiations.
