## **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

A special education hearing in the above-captioned matter was requested via Request for Due Process dated February 4, 2008 and received by the Board on February 6, 2008. The 30-day resolution period runs through March 7, 2008. The original deadline for mailing the final decision and order was April 20, 2008.

A pre-hearing conference in the above-captioned case was held via telephone conference call on February 22, 2008. Attorney Andrew Feinstein appeared on behalf of Student and Attorney Marsha Moses appeared on behalf of the Board of Education. The issues in dispute are reimbursement for unilateral placement, evaluation and compensatory education. Hearings were scheduled for April 1 and April 3, 2008.

Via e-mail dated February 22, 2008, Attorney Feinstein requested an enlargement of time until March 31 for resolution of the matter. This enlargement permitted the parties to pursue resolution through mediation. The deadline for mailing the final decision and order was extended until May 14, 2008.

The parties resolved the matter through mediation and Attorney Feinstein requested that the matter be withdrawn with prejudice.

## **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

In light of the above facts, the above-captioned case is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
