FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board's program for the Student for the 2006-07 school year was appropriate.
- 2. Whether the Board's program for the Student for the 2007-08 school year is appropriate.
- 3. Whether the Board's proposed program for the Student for the 2008-09 school year is appropriate.
- 4. Whether the Board has violated the Student and family's procedural safeguards.
- 5. Whether the Parents' placement of the Student at CCCD Academy for the 2007-08 school year [commencing February 15, 2008], summer 2008, school year 2008-09 and summer 2009 is appropriate.
- 6. Whether the Parents shall be reimbursed for the placement of the Student at CCCD Academy.
- 7. Whether the Parents shall be reimbursed for the home program, Dr. Smaller evaluation, related services and tutoring of the Student.

SUMMARY:

The Board received the Parents' request for hearing on March 3, and a prehearing conference convened on March 11. On April 22, the Parents' attorney submitted notification that the parties had reached a settlement of the case.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**.
