# FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

### **ISSUES:**

- 1. Whether the Student's IEPs offered for the 2006-07, 2007-08, 2008-09 and ESY programs for 2007 and 2008 were appropriate and consistent with 20 U.S. C. Sec. 1412(a)(5)(A).
- 2. Whether the Board shall reimburse the Parents for the independent evaluation of Eileen Luddy, Ph.D.
- 3. Whether the Board shall provide compensatory education to the Student.

# SUMMARY:

The Parents submitted this request for hearing which was received by the Board on May 12, 2008. At the first day of the hearing, the Board's attorney reported that the parties had entered into a settlement agreement in the matter.
