FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board committed procedural violations that resulted in a denial of a free appropriate public education [FAPE] to the Student in the 2007-08 school year.
- 2. Whether the Student shall be placed at the Sound School for the 2008-09 school year.

SUMMARY:

The Father submitted this request for hearing which was received by the Board on July 3. The Mother submitted a notice requesting that she intervene in this matter; the Mother was added as a party to this action. A pre-hearing conference was convened with all parties on July 16.
