FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board's proposed program for the Student for the 2008-09 school year is appropriate.
- **2.** Whether the Parent's proposed placement for the Student at Foundation School for the 2008-09 school year is appropriate.
- **3.** If so, whether the Board shall fund the placement of the Student at the Foundation School for the 2008-09 school year.
- **4.** Whether the Board shall provide for placement of the Student at the Foundation School for the 2009-10 school year.
- **5.** Whether the Board shall reimburse the Parent for the private evaluations of the Student.

SUMMARY:

The Board received this request for hearing on July 16, 2008, and a prehearing conference was convened on July 22, 2008. On September 5, 2008, the Parents' attorney submitted notification that the case had settled.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:
