FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board's proposed program for the Student for the 2008-09 school year is appropriate.
- 2. If not, whether the Parents' proposed placement of the Student at Lorraine D. Foster School for the 2008-09 school year is appropriate.
- 3. Whether the Parents shall be reimbursed for the Wilson tutoring provided for the Student during the ESY 2008.
