FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board's program for the Student for the 2006-07 and 2007-08 were appropriate.
- 2. Whether the Board's proposed program for the Student for the 2008-09 school year is appropriate.
- 3. Whether the Board failed to propose an appropriate ESY program in 2008 for the Student.
- 4. Whether the Board has committed procedural violations which have resulted in a denial of FAPE to the Student during the 2006-07 and 2007-08 school years.
- 5. Whether the Student is entitled to compensatory education.

SUMMARY:

The Board received this request for hearing on July 28, 2008, and a prehearing conference was convened on August 11, 2008. On September 8, 2008, the Parents' attorney submitted notification that the case had settled.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice.
