- 1. Whether the Board's evaluation of the Student was appropriate.
- 2. Whether the Parents shall be reimbursed for the April 2008 private evaluation of the Student.
- 3. Whether the Board's program for the Student for the 2006-07 school year was appropriate.
- 4. Whether the Board's proposed program for the Student for the 2007-08 school year is appropriate.
- 5. Whether the Board shall reimburse the Parents for the summer 2008 program and for the placement at the Academy of the Holy Family for the 2008-09 school year.
