FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the out-of-district placement recommended by the Board at the November 6, 2008 Planning and Placement Team meeting should be implemented without the Parent's consent.
- 2. Whether the psychiatric and educational evaluations of the Student obtained by the Board are appropriate.

SUMMARY/PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

On or about December 18, 2008, the Parent received a request for hearing from the Board. (H.O. Exh. 1)

On December 19, 2008, the undersigned was appointed as hearing officer to preside over the hearing, rule on all motions, determine findings of fact and conclusions of law, and issue an order. (H.O. Exh. 2)

A prehearing conference convened on January 9, 2009. During the prehearing conference, Attorney Mark Sammaruga appeared on behalf of the Board; Attorney Piper Paul appeared on behalf of the Parent.
