FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Student is eligible for special education.
- 2. Whether the Board denied the Student a free appropriate public education for the 2007-08 and 2008-09 school years.
- 3. Whether the Student is entitled to compensatory education.
