FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the School failed to identify the Student as eligible for Special Education Services;
- 2. Whether the Student should be placed at Kildonan School in New York;
- 3. Whether the Board should reimburse the Parents for the all expenses incurred in placing the Student at Kildonan;
- 4. Whether there were procedural violations;
- 5. Whether compensatory education should be provided to the Student.
