# FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

## **ISSUES:**

- 1. Whether the Board failed to provide FAPE;
- 2. Whether the IEP failed to reflect the Student's level of performance;
- 3. Whether the IEP fails to list the Special Education Services provided to the Student with specificity;
- 4. Whether the Board failed to give the Parents meaningful participation;
- 5. Whether the Board failed to consider an Independent Education Evaluation;
- 6. Whether the Board failed to provide a continuum of alternate placements;
- 7. Whether the Board failed to provide assistive technology;
- 8. Whether the Board failed to provide adequate written notice when it refused to change the Student's education placement;
- 9. Whether the Student should be placed at the Ben Bronz Academy.
- 10. Whether the Request for Hearing is premature.

# **SUMMARY:**
