FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

The Board's issues for the hearing are:

- 1. Whether the Student shall be placed in a residential placement in the absence of parental consent.
- 2. Whether the Student's records shall be released so that the Board can make application to residential placement facilities.

The Parents' issues are:

- 1. Whether the Board has provided the Student with an appropriate program.
- 2. Whether the Parents' objection to the residential placement is appropriate, and whether the Student shall be placed in a less restrictive setting.

SUMMARY:

Hearing requests were filed for both parties, and a mailing date of the decision was calculated from the receipt date of the hearing request of June 23, 2009.

A prehearing conference convened on July 2, 2009 and a hearing date was scheduled for August 7, 2009. Prior to the first hearing date, the Board's attorney reported that both cases were settled.
