- 1. Whether the Board failed to identify the Student as eligible for Special Education Services for the 2008-2009 school year;
- 2. Whether the Board failed to provide FAPE for 2008-2009 school year;
- 3. Whether the Board should reimburse the Parents for a unilateral placement and related expenses.
