FINAL DECISION AND ORDER (Clarified)

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board provided the Student with an appropriate program for the 2007-08 and 2008-09 school years;
- 2. Whether the Student is entitled to compensatory education; and
- 3. Whether the Parents shall be reimbursed for the two private evaluations that were conducted by Dr. Nelson Dorta in 2008 and 2009.

SUMMARY:

The Board received this request for hearing on December 31, 2009 and a prehearing conference was convened on January 13, 2010. On January 29, 2010, the Parents' attorney submitted notification that the case had been settled. This matter was dismissed.
