- 1. Whether the Board failed to provide FAPE;
- 2. Whether the Board should pay for the Student's placement at Timberline Knolls;
- 3. Whether the Board should pay for the Student's placement at Greenbrier Academy for the balance of 2009-2010, including extended year services.
