FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board failed to provide FAPE for the inclusive period of March 9, 2008 through the end of summer 2008;
- 2. Whether the Board failed to provide FAPE for the 2008-2009 school year, including extended year services;
- 3. Whether the Board failed to provide FAPE for the 2009-2010 school year;
- 4. Whether the Board committed procedural violations;
- 5. Whether the Board should provide one year of compensatory education to the Student.

SUMMARY:

On March 9, 2010, the Board received the Request for Due Process. On March 29, 2010, a Prehearing Conference was held and hearing dates were scheduled. On April 23, 2010, Counsel for the Parent withdrew the Request for Due Process and requested that the matter be dismissed without prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED without prejudice**.
