FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board offered the Student an appropriate program for the 2008-09 school year.
- 2. Whether the Board failed to appropriately implement the Student's program for the 2008-09 school year.
- 3. Whether the Board offered the Student an appropriate program for the 2009-10 school year.
- 4. Whether the Board failed to appropriately implement the Student's program for the 2009-10 school year.
- 5. Whether the Board failed to provide the Student with an appropriate extended school year program for the summer 08 and the summer 09.
- 6. Whether the Board committed procedural violations as outlined in the hearing request during the 2008-09 and 2009-10 school year.
- 7. Whether the Parents' proposed placement of the Student at a therapeutic day program with related services and a full summer program is appropriate.
- 8. Whether the Student is entitled to two years of compensatory education.

SUMMARY:

The Board received this request for hearing on April 21, 2010 and a prehearing conference was convened on May 6, 2010. On June 2, 2010, the Parents' attorney submitted notification that the case had settled.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice.
