FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

Case No. 11-0007:

1. Whether the Board's evaluation of the Student is appropriate.

Case No. 11-0021:

- 1. Whether the Board has offered the Student an appropriate program for the 2010-11 school year.
- 2. If not, whether the Parents' placement of the Student at Winston Prep is appropriate and shall be reimbursed, including the cost of transportation.

SUMMARY:

In Case No. 11-0007, the Parent received the request for hearing on July 6, 2010. In Case No. 11-0021, the Board received the request for hearing on July 15, 2010.
