FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Student is eligible for Special Education and related services;
- 2. Whether the Board failed to offer FAPE to the Student;
- 3. Whether the Student should be placed at the Jewish High School of Connecticut;
- 4. Whether the Board should pay for the Student's placement at Jewish High School of Connecticut.

SUMMARY:

On July 29, 2010, the Board received the Request for Hearing. The Prehearing Conference was held on August 27, 2010 and hearing dates were scheduled. On September 2, 2010, the Attorney for the Parent notified the Hearing Officer that the parties had reached a settlement agreement, withdrew the Request for Due Process, and requested that the matter be dismissed.
