FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board failed to offer FAPE for the 2010-2011 school year;
- 2. Whether the Student should be placed in a private day placement;
- 3. Whether the Student should be placed at Ben Bronz Academy;
- 4. Whether the Board should pay for the Student's placement at Ben Bronz Academy with transportation.

SUMMARY:

On July 28, 2010, the Board received the Request for Due Process filed by the Parent. A Prehearing Conference was held on August 11, 2010 and hearing dates were scheduled. On October 14, 21, 26, and 28, 2010, hearing dates were held. On October 28, 2010, Counsel for the Parent advised the Hearing Officer that the matter was settled and withdrew the Request for Hearing with prejudice.
