### FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

#### **ISSUES:**

- 1. Whether the Board failed to provide FAPE for the 2007-2008, 2008-2009, and 2009-2010 school years, including extended school year services;
- 2. Whether the Board committed procedural violations;
- 3. Whether the Board should reimburse the Parents for vision therapy, an executive functioning coach, a math tutor, an online tutor, and tuition for Summer 2010;
- 4. Whether the Board should provide compensatory education;
- 5. Whether the above issues are barred by the two-year statute of limitations; and
- 6. Whether the Hearing Officer should override the Parents' refusal to consent.

## **SUMMARY:**

On August 24, 2010, the Board received the Request for Due Process. On August 30, 2010, a Prehearing Conference was held and hearing dates were scheduled. On October 12, 2010, the Parent withdrew the Request for Due Process.

#### FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**.
