FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board knew or should have known that the Student was a student with a disability before the occurrence of the behavior that precipitated the pending disciplinary action in accordance with 34 CFR §300.534.
- 2. Whether the Board shall conduct an expedited evaluation of the Student.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/DISCUSSION:

This expedited request for hearing was received by the Board on November 16, 2010. A prehearing conference convened on November 29, 2010.
