FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board failed to provide FAPE for 2009-2010, and 2010-2011 school years;
2. Whether the Student required an out of district placement, and if so, whether that placement should have been Eagle Hill for the 2010-2011 school year;
3. Whether the Board should have reimbursed the parents for the cost of the Eagle Hill program and placement;
4. Whether the Board committed procedural and substantive violations.

SUMMARY:

On November 22, 2010, the Board received the Request for Due Process. On January 28, 2011 the Parent withdrew the Request for Hearing and requested that the matter be dismissed.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**.
