FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board offered the Student an appropriate program for the 2010-11 school year.
2. Whether the Parent shall be reimbursed for the educational program at Inspirations.
3. Whether the Student shall be placed in his neighborhood school upon his discharge from Inspirations.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/DISCUSSION:

This request for hearing was submitted to the state Department of Education on or about December 6, 2010 and received by the Board via email from the hearing officer on December 8, 2010. The prehearing conference was convened on December 13, 2010.
