FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board offered the Student an appropriate IEP for the 2011-12 school year;
- 2. If not, whether the Student's program shall include the recommendations of Dr. Roscow, that Dr. Roscow be hired to oversee the development and implementation of this IEP, that the Student be provided intensive reading instruction in a location outside the Board school and any other appropriate remedy.
