FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Is the program provided by the Monroe Board of Education for the 2012/2013 School Year, including the Extended School Year, appropriate?
2. If not, is Eagle Hill Southport an appropriate placement for the Student?
3. Should the Student be placed at Eagle Hill Southport?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

The Student filed this due process case on May 22, 2013. This Impartial Hearing Officer was appointed to the matter on May 22, 2013. The deadline for submitting the final decision was established to be August 5, 2013. A prehearing conference was held on June 10, 2013. The Student's father appeared on behalf of the Student and Attorney Moses appeared on behalf of the Board of Education. At that time, hearings were scheduled for July 16, 2013 and July 25, 2013.

On July 11, 2013, the Student's father advised this Impartial Hearing Officer that the matter was resolved and requested that it be dismissed.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

It is ordered that the Student's request for dismissal is granted, and this case is dismissed.
