FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Did the Board offer appropriate evaluations in 2016?

2. If not, is the independent education evaluation proposed by the parents appropriate?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Board initiated this special education due process case on 4/17/18. This Impartial Hearing Officer was assigned to this case on 4/22/18. A Prehearing Conference was convened on 4/30/18. Parents appeared pro se, and Attorney Laubin appeared on behalf of the Board. It was established that the deadline for filing the final decision in this case is 6/29/18. Evidentiary hearings were scheduled for 6/7/18 and 6/12/18.

On 5/29/18, Attorney Laubin reported to the Hearing Officer that the Board would like to withdraw the subject due process complaint since the parents withdrew their request for an independent education evaluation at public expense.

ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
