FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Did the District provide the Student with FAPE for the 2018-19 school year?
- 2. Should the Parents be reimbursed for tuition and other costs for the placement of the Student at Winston Preparatory School?
- 3. Should the Student be provided compensatory education?

SUMMARY AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

Case 18-0460 was commenced by the Parents by request received by the Board on May 15, 2018. A prehearing conference was held on June 19, 2018. At the prehearing conference, hearing dates were set for August 21, 2018; August 22, 2018 and August 23, 2018 and the decision date was determined to be July 27, 2018. The scheduled hearings were subsequently cancelled and the decision date extended to October 26, 2018.

On October 17, 2018, the undersigned hearing officer was advised by the attorney for the Parents that the parties had reached a settlement in the case and the matter should therefore be dismissed with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is dismissed with prejudice.
